What does ISOC expect from Chapters?

- **NEW!** Minimum “performance standards”
 - Inform, Educate, Influence and/or Implement
- Chapters must:
 - Establish with 25 members
 - 3% Membership growth (average over 3 years)
 - An Internet presence
 - Conduct one mission related event/12 months
 - Share ISOC policy positions with ISOC
 - Transparent leadership succession processes
- ISOC Global must:
 - Provide leadership development, training etc..

- 目的：

- 手段：

具体的な活動

- ・ インターネット関連組織活動を日本のコミュニティに広く知ってもらう
 - － ISOC, ICANN, IETF, RIR 等が何をやっていて、どのように動いているか。
 - ・ 目的は、「人材」の増強
- ・ 日本のインターネットに関する状況などをISOC (=世界) に広く伝えていく。

現在

- BoFで興味を持った人のメールアドレスを集めてメールリストを作った
- メールリスト上を使い、日本のISOCへ興味を持つ人のコミュニティにおいて今後の活動に関する方向性について議論し、合意点を探す事を開始

予定

- ISOC-JP コミュニティ内で活動の方向性の合意
 - 最長で 2011 年中くらいかかる可能性あり
- rejuvenate の手続きを取る
- 活動を行う
