



- Founded 1997, and still run by volunteers and donations
- 7200 mailing list members
- Meetings
 - Held twice a year, usually January and July
 - 3 days of plenary sessions
 - 1500+ attendees
- Discussions are in Japanese
 - Foreign languages are acceptable but casual translation is recommended


Code of Conduct

- No registration fee
 - Meals/drinks at your own
- A meeting host arranges every needed facilities
 - Responsible for the meeting budget
 - Seeks sponsors. We have 90 sponsors now days
 - Usually, an event organizer gets involved to organize the meeting, and they open a bank account to receive funds from sponsors
